1. To confirm your booking

- Written confirmation of your booking to be returned by fax to (03) 9012 3580 or emailed to info@emergentfutures.com
- Once this confirmation is received, we will issue an invoice for the fee, which must be paid within fourteen (14) days in order to secure your booking.
- After the presentation or workshop is completed a final invoice will be issued to cover all expenses incurred by Emergent Futures and payment for any extra services relating to the booking

2. Expenses

- Expenses, where applicable, will be booked by Emergent Futures office and billed to you for reimbursement.
- Within Australia all flights will be based on economy flights.
- We will minimise and share client expenses wherever possible
- Supporting invoices/receipts from our suppliers will be available for verification if required.

3. Recording & Copyright (Keynotes and presentations)

 We require our agreement before any recording of presentations or distribution of our material or presentations is made.

4. Cancellations

- In the event of a cancellation being made more than 60 days from the date of the event, a refund of 50% of the presentation or workshop fee will be given with the remaining 50% of the fee being held as a credit for use for any of our services.
- In the event of a cancellation being made within 60 days from the date of the event, 100% of the presentation fee will be held as a credit for use for any of our services
